WORKSHOP LEADER DAVID LAWRENCE

David Lawrence is one of the UK's most versatile conductors, working with orchestras, symphony choruses and choirs of all genres. He was nominated for a Gramophone Award, awarded a prestigious ARAM by the Royal Academy of Music, and holds the Guinness World Record for conducting the UK's largest choir. He is a popular guest conductor, and an experienced and respected trainer of choral conductors. David led a very successful Workshop for us in 2019 and we are delighted that he has accepted our invitation to return.

WORKSHOP MUSIC

Echo Magnificat and Nunc Dimittis composed by Paul Ayres has been chosen for this workshop by David Lawrence. It is written as a strict canon - there is only one vocal melody, which overlaps with itself. Paul writes "I love canons, fugues, rounds, ostinatos, list songs, and all sorts of music which has an obvious structure. It's not, I hope, that the end result is "head rather than heart" or "thought rather than feeling" - but "head AND heart" and "thought AND feeling" - the whole lot!"

Sacred Choruses edited by John Rutter includes pieces from some of the finest masses, requiems and oratorios from the seventeenth to the twentieth century.

The music for this workshop has been chosen to engage and be enjoyed by singers of all levels.
