### SINGING DAY LEADER – Joseph Judge

Conductor, Music Director, Producer, Orchestrator, and Singer, Joseph Judge is Chorus Master of the Leeds Philharmonic Chorus, Artistic Director of the Exon Festival, a Hallé Associate Artist as Director of the Hallé Choral Academy, a frequent collaborator as a Score Reader/Orchestrator with the Northern Film Orchestra, and a Music Director for Film/TV productions. He prepares Leeds Philharmonic Chorus for concerts with professional orchestras such as the Hallé and leads the annual Exon Festival in Tavistock, which often features live on BBC Radio. He has led music sessions for Sony PlayStation. As Director of the Hallé Choral Academy, he inspires mixed ability singers to develop their vocal technique and sight-reading abilities through the singing of core repertoire. As a Countertenor, he continues to perform regularly as an oratorio soloist.

### ACCOMPANIST – Irina Kosogova

Irina is a talented professional pianist who accompanies many choirs in the West Country including Plymouth Philharmonic. She is much in demand for piano recitals and as a teacher.

**Messiah**, composed in 1741, is a powerful and uplifting oratorio written by George Frideric Handel that tells the story of Christ's life, death and resurrection. We will be singing selected choruses using the Novello Watkins Shaw Edition.
