Conductor for Exeter Festival Chorus and formerly a professional soprano, Andrea Brown is renowned as a leading UK choral conductor. She is Head of Choral Conducting at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama, leading and teaching the postgraduate programme, and also Visiting Professor of Choral Conducting at the Janacek Academy of Music and Performing Arts, Czechia. Recently Associate Choral Conducting Examiner at the Royal Academy of Music, Andrea was elected as an Associate of the Royal College of Music in recognition of her significant contribution to the field of Choral Conducting. She holds masterclasses for choirs and conductors in the UK and abroad. We look forward to benefiting from her considerable expertise and enjoying her style of conducting which has been described as having ‘spirit and vitality, with musical integrity always at its core.’
